**ORDER GRANTING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER'S APPLICATION TO  
PROVIDE NOTICE OF LIQUIDATION, SET CLAIMS FILING DEADLINE, AND  
ESTABLISH A CLAIMS PROCESSING PROCEDURE**

The Court considered the SDR's Application to Provide Notice of Liquidation, Set Claims Filing Deadline, and Establish a Claims Processing Procedure (the "Application"). Having considered the Application, the Court finds that notice of the Application is proper, that the Application is meritorious, in the best interests of the receivership estate, and should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Application is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Court, as follows:


1. Approves the manner and form of notice of liquidation and the opportunity to file claims set out in the Application;
2. Approves the proof of claim form set out in the Application;
3. Approves the SDR's proposal concerning the processing of proofs of claim set out in the Application;
4. Authorizes the SDR to provide email notice only to the known potential claimants as set out in the Application;
5. Authorizes the SDR to provide publication notice to unknown claimants;
6. Finds that the notice requirements of Section 443.155 of the receivership statute are


met when notice is given to the categories and timeframes of known potential claimants available from the electronic and physical records as set out in the Application;

- 7. Approves the SDR's plan for using the books and records of the Webb Title estate for providing notice;
- 8. Approves the proposed POC form and notices attached as Exhibit C in the Application;
- 9. Approves the SDR's plan for addressing late claims as set out in the Application;
- 10. Finds that the manner of notice described therein meets with the requirements Section 443.155;
- 11. Approves the SDR's plan for processing the claims in this estate as set out in the Application;
- 12. Establishes a claims filing deadline of 11:59 p.m. C.D.T, October 14, 2008; and
- 13. Finds that entry of this Order is without prejudice to Fidelity's rights to pursue its Motion to Lift Stay and to pursue Fidelity's lawsuit against Webb County in the event the Motion to Lift Stay is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the SDR is authorized to execute any documents, and take any other action necessary to carry out the purposes of this Order.
