**ORDER DENYING FIDELITY NATIONAL TITLE INSURANCE COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY**

On the undersigned day the Court considered the *Motion for Relief from Injunction and Automatic Stay* (the "Motion") filed by Fidelity National Title Insurance Company ("Fidelity") and the *Response in Opposition to the Motion for Relief from Automatic Stay [Fidelity National Title Insurance Company]* filed by Cantilo & Bennett, L.L.P., Special Deputy Receiver of Webb County Title & Abstract Company, Inc. (the "SDR" and "Webb County" respectively) and the *Objection to Fidelity National Title Insurance Company's Motion for Relief from Injunction and Automatic Stay* filed by the Texas Title Insurance Guaranty Association ("TTIGA").

When called for hearing, Movant Fidelity and Objectors the SDR and TTIGA appeared and announced ready.

Having considered the Motion, the responses in opposition and the evidence presented at hearing, and the recommendation of the Special Master appointed in this proceeding, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the Motion and the parties, that notice was proper, that Fidelity seeks relief under TEX. INS. CODE § 443.008(h), that the Master has recommended that the Motion be denied and that the Motion should be denied.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

- 1. The Motion is DENIED.
