**ORDER APPROVING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER'S SECOND AMENDED
APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF FEES AND EXPENSES**

On this day came on to be heard the *Second Amended Application for Approval of Fees and Expenses* ("Application") filed by Cantilo & Bennett, L.L.P., Special Deputy Receiver of Webb County Title & Abstract Company, Inc. (the "SDR" and "Webb County" respectively), The Special Deputy Receiver appeared by and through its counsel. Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Order of Reference to Master* ("Order of Reference") entered by this Court on April 10, 2008 provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;

2. The Application was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;

3. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application were filed;

4. The Texas Title Insurance Guaranty Association has filed an Acknowledgement of Notice and Waiver of Objection.

5. The Special Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure;


6. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder;

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows::

1. The Application is GRANTED in all respects.
2. The Court's Order Approving the SDR's Application for Approval of Fees and Expenses is MODIFIED to approve the subcontractors and the hourly rates and fees described in the SDR's Second Amended Application for Approval of Fees and Expenses and all other terms and provisions of the Court's order of July 22, 2008 remain in effect.
3. The SDR is authorized to take any action necessary to carry out this Order.
