ORDER APPROVING TEXAS TITLE INSURANCE GUARANTY ASSOCIATION'S  
APPLICATION TO EXTEND CLAIM-FILING DEADLINE

On this day the Court heard the Texas Title Insurance Guaranty Association's ("TTIGA's") Application to Extend Claim-Filing Deadline (the "Application"). TTIGA appeared by and through its counsel. Having considered the Application, and the recommendation of the Special Master appointed in this proceeding (the "Master"), the Court finds as follows:

1. *The Order of Reference to Master* ("Order of Reference") entered by this Court <sup>on</sup> ~~of~~ <sup>TAC</sup> April 10, 2008 provides that the Application is referred to the Master.
2. The Application was submitted to the Master.
3. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE s. 443.007 and the Order of Reference.
4. No objections to the Application were filed.
5. The Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.
6. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties in interest; and
7. The Application should be GRANTED in all respects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Application is GRANTED, and TTIGA's claim-filing deadline is extended to **May 24, 2011**.
